Date & Time: 8:15-15:00 on March 26th, 9:00-15:00 on 27th & 28th

Participants: Around 35 Japanese senior high school students, 3 professional English teachers and 6 international students studying at Kyushu University.

Objective:

1. Japanese students practice speaking and making a presentation in English to boost their confidence in stating their opinions in English.
2. Through interaction with international students, Japanese students broaden their views and have more interest in global society.
3. Stimulated by international students' future goal, Japanese students try to think about their future goal more seriously.

Merit for international students:

1. This program helps international students know more about Japanese culture and the mindset of young Japanese people.
2. We believe that through this program, international students will also get a chance to think about their future goal more seriously and get a clearer vision of their future.

International students' role:

1. Actively communicate with Japanese students based on the decided topics.
2. Present about your home country to Japanese students.
3. Present about your future goal, steps being taken to achieve the goal and how the current experience studying in Japan is useful to achieve their goal.
4. Support Japanese students make an effective presentation in English.

Required conditions for international students

- ✓ Must be able to communicate in English fluently.
- ✓ Must hold a valid work permit (資格外活動許可書).
