Students participate in medium- or long-term study abroad (91 days or more), short-term study abroad, or online study abroad programs and earn at least 4 credits. Only credits earned at a host university during study abroad that are approved for credit transfer by Kyushu University are recognized as valid. If fewer than 4 credits are earned at the host institution, students may combine credits earned through another short-term or online study-abroad program, as well as credits earned from the Overseas Challenge Course Group on campus.

3-1 APRU online study abroad program

Kyushu University is a member of the international university consortium, the Association of Pacific Rim Universities (APRU), which offers the Virtual Student Exchange Program (VSE) as an online study-abroad program. The VSE Academic Courses allow students to take online classes provided by APRU member universities, and undergraduate students at our university can enroll free of charge.

Regarding Course Enrollment Requirements

Students with an English proficiency equivalent to a TOEFL score of 490 or higher may enroll. Please note that some courses include specific requirements or restrictions, such as enrollment conditions and classroom size limits. The final decision on acceptance into a class will be made by the course instructor. Please keep this in mind when planning your course schedule.

Regarding Course Recognition and Grading

- (1) KIKAN education courses offered in the International Program will be recognized as “General Education Courses (Open Courses)” in the regular undergraduate curriculum.
- (2) The course name will include “IUPE” before the English title of the international course.
Example: 基礎化学Ⅰ → IUPE Basic Chemistry I
- (3) Grades will be evaluated on a five-level scale: S, A, B, C, F; however, they will not be included in the GPA calculation.
